Extract from the constitution of SLAAP

ARTICLE I. MISSION

“ To improve the quality of life of those engaged in the Animal industry, and to enable the production and supply of quality dairy, meat, poultry, fish and other animal (by) products”.

ARTICLE II. NAME AND OFFICE

1. The Association will be called “The Sri Lanka Association of Animal Production” and will be herein-after referred to as “SLAAP”. (Animal includes Fish, and will be hereafter referred to as Animal)
2. The registered office and place for transacting the business of the SLAAP shall be the Department of Animal Science, Faculty of Agriculture, University of Peradeniya, Peradeniya or any other place decided by the general body. However, meetings could be convened in other places as determined by the Executive Committee of the SLAAP herein-after referred to as the “Committee”.

ARTICLE III. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

1. To promote and assist the advancement of the Animal Industry in general with especial emphasis on Policy, Production, Development, Education, Research, Training, Extension, Processing and Marketing.
2. To create a forum so as to promote interaction between members engaged in the field of Animal Production, facilitate fellowship, exchange ideas and develop links, which would enable them to work as a group.
3. public awareness and to promote dissemination of information available in all aspects of Animal Production by publications including Popular articles, a ‘Farmers Bulletin’ and a Scientific Journal to be called the ‘Sri Lanka Journal of Animal Production’.

ARTICLE IV. MEMBERSHIP

1. Scientists, academics, policy makers, extensionists, trainers, entrepreneurs engaged in livestock production and/or development can apply for ordinary membership in the prescribed form together with the annual subscription to the Secretary of the Association. Upon admission to the membership, he/she will be enrolled as an associate member for a minimum period of two years, after which he/she will be eligible for ordinary membership.
2. Individuals who apply for ordinary membership in the prescribed form together with the annual subscription will become full-pledged member after six months of approval of membership by the executive committee.
3. Corporate membership shall be open to the established organizations/societies directly involved in the field of animal production/industry. Depending on the size/strength of the organization, memberships up to a maximum of 5 could be obtained (1 per 1000 members registered).
4. All life/ordinary/corporate members shall have the right to vote, to be nominated to office in the Association, to propose and second the candidate of another member and to receive all communications from the Secretary.
5. Any government department or institution having an interest in the Livestock Industry may become patron member of the Association, on the invitation of the executive committee.
6. This membership is for those individuals selected by the governing body of the Association for special recognition on the basis of outstanding and unique contribution made to the progress of the Association and/or industry.

ARTICLE V. DUES OR LEVIES AND ARREARS

1. a. The annual subscription for an ordinary member shall be Rs. 300/=
- b. The subscription for a life member shall be Rs.1500/=
- c. The annual subscription for each corporate membership shall be Rs. 3,000/=
